Kay Duncan is a Kiwi Singer/Songwriter & Interdisciplinary artist based in Christchurch.

Her melodies are powerful, soulful, and are abundant with emotive undercurrents. She is a storyteller with thought provoking lyrics, she likes to keep it real and authentic. With her strong vocals and unique mix of soul, alt-folk, country, blues and jazz her music has a broad appeal.

Originally from the Naval port Island city of Portsmouth in England, Kay began performing and writing songs when she was 11 years old, and enjoyed singing in local clubs there.

She was the lead singer in the Christchurch jazz band “The Flying Dixies” and also works in collaboration with her composer and pianist husband Guy Hobson.

She performs Solo, duo with Guy & with her recently formed Band- Kay Duncan Band.

Her Debut album ‘Interstellar Refugee’ -available on Bandcamp, was recorded, produced and mixed in her home - based studio, with final mastering by Ian Tilley. It was released in 2022 and features Guy Hobson on keyboard, and local music genius Stephen McDaid on lead guitar.

Kay is already building her audience and has loyal followers. Her sell out concert in 2023 is testimony to the local support and interest that she is starting to receive.

Her music has been played on local Radio Stations and on Radio Stations in the USA that streams Worldwide.

Kay is planning a new concert for 2024 which will feature a stellar line up of professional local musicians.
